What to bring to my programs

Please label your items and keep them in your own backpack. This

Medication

Our Support Workers can help you with your medication during the program.

Please make sure:

- ☆ You have provided Gateways with a GP-signed medication sheet
- ☆ Any liquids or creams are in their original packaging with labels intact

You may also need:

- ☆ MYKI card, look for this symbol: **PT**➤
- ☆ Money for food and drinks
- ☆ Bathers and towel (for water activities)
- ☆ Other items needed for the activity are listed below in What to bring

- ☆ Any tablets are in a Webster pack

Funding

If you have an NDIS plan, NDIS rates apply. These activities are covered under 'Core Supports' or 'Social and Community Participation.'

Support costs are taken from your NDIS plan. Out-of-pocket costs are separate and some non-face to face charges apply.

Out-of-pocket costs and pre-booked activities

Some activities have extra costs, which depend on the activity eg. entry fees. We aim to keep these costs as low as possible.

Gateways pre-books some activities. If you cancel and we can't fill your spot, you may still need to pay the activity fee. Please give us as much notice as possible to avoid this.

Companion Card

Please note that if you do not have a Companion Card, you may incur an additional cost on top of the out-of-pocket fee. This apportioned cost is shared among participants without a companion card to cover the support worker's expenses during the program. Important update for recreation fees

NDIS no longer covers activity fees. These must now be paid out of pocket. All activity costs must be paid in full before the program begins. We have payment options available, please contact us for more information.

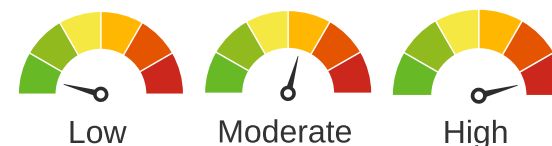
Pick up and drop off service

Transport to and from the program may be available at an extra cost to your NDIS plan. This depends on the program and support worker availability.

Please contact us to arrange transport support.

Running late to an activity or for pick up?

If you are running late, please call us as soon as possible.

If you're running late for drop-off and we don't hear from you, and it's more than 10 minutes past the scheduled time, the group may leave, and any late participants might miss the session. If you're late for pick-up at end of day and our staff are required to stay longer, you may be charged for the extra time.

Cancellations

If you cancel within 7 days of the program (including due to illness or COVID-19), you may still be charged for support, as per the NDIS price guide. The cost will depend on whether we can fill your spot.

Some out-of-pocket costs may apply if we can't find a replacement, no matter when you cancel.
