- Shared Community Living Services (for four or more individuals) and have a number of new services due to start to meet the increasing demand for our expertise,
- Independent Living Services (for up to four people) in privately rented or owned accommodation, and
- Medium Term Accommodation (MTA)
- Gateways also manages three houses for children with complex disabilities who are unable to live with their families.

Our staff are available to support people in their day-to-day routines and to engage in meaningful activities, building on skills, capacity for independence and community inclusion. Support ranges from daytime and evening support, to sleep overs and weekends.
