The 9-week program is designed and delivered by Gateways therapists. There is a pre and post gross motor assessment that will take place to inform outcomes. Each one-hour session aims to:

- Increase attention and concentration,
- Enhance social interactions, leading to new friendships,
- Increase communication and social skills,
- Develop body awareness and strengthen fine and gross motor skills,
- Give children a platform to develop empathy and adaptability to different situations,
- Enhance memory and summarising skills
- To teach strategies to support enhancing memory and other executive function skills.

Delivered in a fun and engaging play-based program, Groove & Move is a great option for youngsters who enjoy dance and rhythm to develop skills while doing something they love. Each session follows the same structure to support learning and skills development.
